ABOUT THE AREA

Caunes-Minervois is a small medieval town and commune in the Aude department in the Occitanie region in southern France. It is known particularly for its ancient Abbey, dating from the eighth century, and the outstanding red marble that has been quarried locally from Roman times.

The area is famous for wine connoisseurs.

The red wines of Minervois have often been associated with quantity rather than quality. But there are real treasures to be discovered, particularly from the area of La Livinière.

Famed for its red marble, used in the château de Versailles, the Louvre and the Opéra de Paris, but also its 13th century Benedictine abbey, Caunes-Minervois is located 25 minutes north-east of Carcassonne. The light at the end of a summer's day gives a walk through the paved, narrow streets in this medieval village a warm, gentle feel.

In Caunes-Minervois, we pay no attention to time as we focus on the signs of a rich Renaissance past. Here, there's a carved wooden door, there a mullion window or even the remains of the walls which protected the village. Walking along the narrow streets, you discover the façades of mansions dating from the 11th to 18th centuries, evidence of the rich local bourgeois: the old Maison Vidal (rue de l'église), Hôtel Sicard with its mullion corner windows or the Hôtel d'Alibert and its internal courtyard, a magnificent example of the Italian Renaissance influence.
