The vast majority of nearby beaches are located outside Bogazici, so be prepared to travel to get to the best. But this means that most of these are natural beaches, which many tourists have a special affinity for and therefore appreciate. The highest-rated beaches in the area are: Lujo Bodrum Beach, Le Meridien Beach, Crystal Green Beach and Sunset Beach.

Cosmopolitan Bodrum in Turkey sits on the west coast and is a thriving destination for both holidaymakers and ex-pats looking to move and live abroad permanently. Having long promoted a hedonistic lifestyle, it attracts all levels of society from budget backpackers to world-renowned millionaires. Known for windmills, and whitewashed houses dotted over the hillside.

Bodrum is part of the district of Mugla Province in the south-western Aegean region of Turkey. The climate in Bodrum is typical of the southern Mediterranean; the summers are long and hot, followed by average autumn temperatures of 20+°C, short winters with lows of 10°C and an early spring.
