Sumptuous work done by traditional artisans and high quality materials. Some of the wood work was done by the artisan who renovated the Orient-Express Wagons, some doors and accessories come from the famous Savoy hotel in London, wooden corbels from a wine domain, cobblestone floor tiles from Italy and interior finitions from LASSCO.

A pretty 19th Century fountain in the courtyard has been converted into a small pool. The whole of the outdoor space is about 50 m2. Home sold partially furnished.
