For as long as it's been around, Dublin has looked beyond Irish shores for inspiration. Dublin is also a hotbed for sports with the iconic Croke Park, 85k seated stadium 11km away and home to Ireland's rugby and soccer teams is The Aviva Stadium, just 7km away. For horse racing there are the beautiful Leopardstown, The Curragh and Fairyhouse courses nearby.

Golf enthusiasts will not be disappointed either as Dublin is next to many of the country's world famous courses including The Grange, Luttrellstown Castle, Sutton, Killiney, The Royal Dublin and Portmarnock Golf Clubs to name but a few.
