All residents can access either communal or private outdoor spaces, with several apartments having balconies and private roof terraces.

Located a pleasant 11-minute walk from the development or two minutes by tram, MediaCityUK is currently undergoing a £1bn expansion plan,

The development is perfectly positioned in an area which is a main thoroughfare between Manchester and Salford and is quickly becoming a new hub for residential development and city living. It is a centre for independent bakeries, bars, and coffee shops, and provides residents with outstanding transport links.

Directly opposite, on the southern bank of the River Irwell lies Pomona Island. The area is undergoing an ambitious masterplan of regeneration over 26 acres which will provide 2,500 homes and 750,000 sqft of commercial space. The whole area is being transformed and will provide a source of social activity for residents when complete, further enhancing the neighbourhood.

The development offers outstanding connectivity to all areas of Manchester via the Metrolink Tram network. Exchange Quay tram stop is a short 4-minute walk away, and from there, it's just two minutes into MediaCityUK and 10 minutes to Deansgate and Manchester city centre.
