ABOUT THE AREA

Piverone is a charming medieval village situated in the Metropolitan City of Turin, perched on the scenic morainic hills of the Canavese region in Northern Italy. This historic 'ricetto' (fortified shelter) is famous for its well-preserved 13th-century clock tower and narrow stone streets that offer a journey back in time. The village serves as a gateway to the Ivrea Morainic Amphitheatre, providing visitors with a unique landscape of rolling hills, ancient vineyards, and deep-rooted agricultural traditions.

The area is particularly renowned for its connection to Lake Viverone, which lies just below the village and is the third-largest lake in Piedmont. The lakeshore is a UNESCO World Heritage site due to its prehistoric pile-dwelling (stilt house) settlements dating back to the Bronze Age. Today, the lake serves as a hub for both relaxation and adventure, offering activities such as water skiing, sailing, and peaceful lakeside walks, all set against the backdrop of the verdant Alpine foothills.

Gastronomy and viticulture are central to Piverone's identity, as it sits in the heart of the Erbaluce di Caluso wine region. The sun-drenched slopes surrounding the village are covered in pergolas of Erbaluce grapes, producing high-quality white wines that have held DOCG status for decades. Visitors can explore the local 'Cantina della Serra,' one of the most historic wine cooperatives in the region, to sample local specialties like fried lake fish and traditional agnolotti pasta paired with these crisp, native wines.

For international and domestic travelers, Piverone is exceptionally well-connected to major transport hubs. The nearest major airport is Turin Airport (TRN), also known as Torino Caselle, located approximately 55 km to the southwest, roughly a 45-minute drive. For a wider range of international long-haul flights, Milan Malpensa Airport (MXP) is a convenient alternative situated about 90 km to the east, making the village an accessible retreat for those exploring the Piedmont and Aosta Valley regions.
