ABOUT THE AREA

Kecskemét is a city with county rights located in central Hungary, serving as the capital of Bács-Kiskun county. Situated on the Great Hungarian Plain, between the Danube and Tisza rivers, it holds historical significance as a market town, a designation it maintained for centuries. The fertile sandy soil surrounding Kecskemét has earned it the moniker 'Orchard of Hungary,' renowned for its fruit cultivation, particularly apricots, which are used to produce the region's famous apricot brandy, pálinka. The city's history dates back to the Árpád dynasty, and it later thrived under Ottoman rule, which granted it special protection, allowing it to develop its unique agricultural and trading character.

Culturally, Kecskemét boasts a rich heritage, evident in its diverse architecture, which notably features numerous prominent examples of Hungarian Art Nouveau. The city's main square is adorned with stunning buildings in this style, including the City Hall and the Cifrapalota (Ornamented Palace). Kecskemét is also known for its vibrant arts scene, hosting the biennial Kecskemét Animation Film Festival, which draws international attention. The city is the birthplace of the renowned composer Zoltán Kodály, whose legacy is preserved through the internationally acclaimed Zoltán Kodály Institute of Music Pedagogy. While Kecskemét does have a local air base (Kecskemét Air Base – LHKE), it primarily serves military purposes and hosts air shows rather



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than regular commercial passenger flights. Therefore, Budapest Airport serves as the primary gateway for air travel to and from Kecskemét.

Kondor EcoLodge is about 80kms South of Budapest Airport and 25kms West of Kecskemét City, North of the road52, between 2 tiny settlements of Fülöpháza and Balázspuszta at the 16th km-stone on the road between Kerekegyháza and Szabadszállás.

Directions

If you come by car from Budapest use highway number 5 South towards Kecskemet, but leave the highway at Lajosmizse, then in Lajosmizse follow the sign towards Kerekegyhaza. This road is quite uneven. From Kerekegyhaza turn towards Szabadszállás. After about 5 kms at the 16th kilometer-stone you will see a sign to right with Kondor Tanya Panzio.

You can reach us by public transportation from Budapest as well, using a train starting from Nyugati Railway Station. At Kecskemét the bus station is walking distance from the main railway station. But be aware that daily just 1 or 2 buses which you can use to stop at our EcoLodge without changing buses.
