From various points within the town, visitors can admire the majestic peak of Etna looming above, while facing south, the vista stretches out to encompass the city of Catania, the sweeping coastline leading to the Gulf of Siracusa, and even Calabria on mainland Italy. This spectacular setting has earned Trecastagni the affectionate title of 'the balcony of Etna,' making it a popular destination for those seeking both natural beauty and a tranquil escape. The town's name, often interpreted as 'three chestnut trees,' is sometimes believed to derive from its three patron saints, Alfio, Cirino, and Filadelfo, adding a layer of local folklore to its identity.
