The complex also features a historic Pigeon Tower, built in the late 18th or early 19th Century, which is divided into five sections, including a dedicated workshop space. Overall, the entire property complex boasts a 'C' rating following a full Energy Diagnostics assessment.

Sorrus is a small, peaceful commune located in the Pas-de-Calais department of the Hauts-de-France region in northern France. Characterized by its quiet, rural ambiance, the village provides a perfect contrast to the bustling seaside resorts nearby. Life in Sorrus revolves around its agricultural heritage and its close-knit community feel. This area of France is known for its gently rolling countryside, offering a tranquil backdrop for residents while still maintaining excellent connectivity to major roads and tourist hubs. Sorrus embodies the authentic charm of the French interior, making it an appealing location for those seeking a quiet residential base with easy access to coastal amenities.

While Lille is the primary hub for international connections, a closer alternative offering regional and some European flights is Le Touquet – Côte d'Opale Airport (LTQ), which is much nearer but serves fewer routes. For those traveling from the UK, the Calais-Dover ferry and the Eurotunnel terminal are also relatively accessible transport options, making Sorrus highly connected to both mainland Europe and the United Kingdom.
