Former presbytery dating from the 15th century, with its own dovecote. This beautiful stone-built residence offers 145 m2 and includes 3 to 4 bedrooms (including a superb master suite with its own shower room and walk-in closet), 2 bathrooms in total, a spacious living area of nearly 40m2 with a private terrace, as well as large vaulted cellars full of character and history.

- Location: Delightful village with all amenities, located 5 minutes from Roujan (a lively village with all shops), 15 minutes from Pezenas (a charming medieval town) and 30 minutes from the beaches.



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- Basement floor: 2 large vaulted cellars of almost 60 m2 each.
 - Ground floor: 6 m2 entrance hall with a stunning period stone staircase, large 42.76 m2 master suite including a 25.20 m2 bedroom with beautiful exposed stone walls, a 5.85 m2 en-suite shower room (Italian shower, WC, double-sink vanity) and an 11.71 m2 walk-in closet, 17.66 m2 bedroom, 18 m2 lounge (or bedroom) with original stone sink and pellet stove.
 - 1st floor: 5.18 m2 landing hall, large 4 m2 storage cupboard, spacious living area (with a beautiful 4m high ceiling) of nearly 40 m2 including a cosy lounge with wood stove and an open-plan dining room/kitchen (lower units, central island, electric oven, electric hob, hood, dishwasher) with access to the terrace via sliding glass doors, charming terrace of about 15 m2 with no overlooking, 7.10 m2 bathroom (bathtub, WC, sink).
 - 2nd floor: 7 m2 bedroom in the former dovecote.

Miscellaneous: Double glazing throughout, wooden shutters, reversible air conditioning, oil-fired central heating, wood stove and pellet stove, roof in good condition, original stone and wooden floors, connected to mains drainage, no work required, annual property tax of 1350 Euros estimated amount of annual energy consumption for standard use: between 2020 Euros and 2810 Euros per year.
