The views from the property offer the best of both worlds: a classic street view looking toward the charming town center, and a peaceful countryside view to the rear, overlooking the rolling green hills and granite peaks characteristic of the Limbara massif.

Strategic Investment Opportunity

One of the most compelling aspects of this listing is the potential to acquire more of the building. The ground floor is also available for €30,000, which requires more extensive refurbishment but offers the chance to own a significant portion of the structure. Additionally, while the first floor is currently held by other owners, there is a potential path to negotiate its purchase in the future, effectively creating a private multi-level villa. For those interested in gardening or expansion, land is available directly behind the house.

Calangianus is ideally situated for those who want a quiet, authentic lifestyle while remaining close to Sardinia's world-famous amenities.

ABOUT THE AREA



Located in the heart of the Gallura region in northeastern Sardinia, Calangianus is a picturesque town nestled in a granite basin about 500 meters above sea level. Protected by the wooded hills of the Limbara massif, the town is famous for its lush landscapes of cork oaks and holm oaks. Its historic center is a charming labyrinth of narrow alleys paved in granite, reflecting the prosperity of a community that has skillfully utilized its natural resources for centuries.

Calangianus is globally recognized as the 'Italian Capital of Cork.' The town's economy has been centered around the extraction and processing of cork since the 19th century, making it one of the most industrialized and wealthiest municipalities in Sardinia. Visitors can explore this unique heritage at the Museum of Cork (Museo del Sughero), housed in a restored 18th-century Capuchin convent, which displays ancient machinery and artisanal techniques used to create everything from wine stoppers to fashion accessories.

Beyond its industrial fame, the area is a treasure trove for history and nature lovers. The surrounding countryside is dotted with fascinating archaeological sites, including the Pascaredda Giants' Tomb and the Nuraghe Agnu, which date back to the Bronze Age. For those seeking outdoor adventure, the nearby Mount Limbara offers numerous trekking and cycling trails, such as the scenic Voie Verte, providing breathtaking panoramic views of the rugged Sardinian interior.

The nearest airport to Calangianus is Olbia Costa Smeralda Airport (OLB), located approximately 30 to 40 kilometers to the east. The drive from the airport takes about 40 minutes via the SS127 highway. While Olbia is the most convenient gateway, travelers can also use Alghero Fertilia Airport (AHO), which is about 120 kilometers away, or Cagliari Elmas Airport (CAG) for a wider range of international connections.
