With the recently expanded port infrastructure, the island is now also an attractive place for boat owners, who can explore the neighboring islands with their hidden bays, turquoise waters and secluded beaches from here. The crossings are often accompanied by encounters with dolphins and sea turtles. Calypso Bay on Othonoi in particular is considered one of the most beautiful bays in the entire Mediterranean.

Ereikoussa at first sight. Originally conceived as a private retreat for family and friends, the villa was later transformed into an elegant boutique hotel to make the beauty and special atmosphere of the island accessible to others.

With an area of about 4.5 square kilometers and a small population - usually no more than 500 inhabitants - the island is a truly tranquil place, ideal for travelers seeking relaxation and unspoiled nature.
