While the new owners are under no obligation to continue these public activities, a dedicated network of volunteers and the 'La Pomme d'Or' association (The Golden Apple) are available to help maintain these cherished traditions.

Visitors are captivated by the English-style flower gardens, a succession of 'green rooms' enclosed by hornbeams and yews that reveal a tapestry of perennial flowerbeds. This Orangery serves as a premier event venue, with a capacity for 100 seated people, perfect for receptions, birthdays, and dinners. Every May, the gardens become resplendent for the 'Fête des Jardiniers,' an event that has historically drawn over 1,500 visitors to the estate.

## ABOUT THE AREA

Thiers is a strikingly picturesque medieval town located in the Puy-de-Dôme department of the Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes region in central France. Perched dramatically on a rocky outcrop overlooking the Durole River valley, the town is divided into a modern 'lower town' and a historic 'upper town.' The upper district is a labyrinth of steep, winding streets lined with timber-framed houses, some dating back to the 15th century, such as the famous Hôtel du Pirou. Its unique vertical layout offers spectacular panoramic views of the Limagne plain and the distant volcanic peaks of the Chaîne des Puys.



Known globally as the 'Capital of Cutlery,' Thiers has been the beating heart of France's knife-making industry for over 800 years. This industrial heritage was born from the power of the Durolle River, which once turned the massive grinding stones used by local craftsmen. Today, the town remains responsible for approximately 70% of all French cutting tools. Visitors can explore this legacy at the Musée de la Coutellerie (Cutlery Museum) or by walking through the 'Valley of Factories,' a hauntingly beautiful stretch along the river where old industrial workshops still cling to the cliffs.

The town serves as a gateway to the Livradois-Forez Regional Natural Park, making it an ideal base for hikers and nature enthusiasts. Beyond its industrial grit, Thiers hosts vibrant cultural events like Coutellia, the world's largest art knife festival, and the Pamparina music festival, which fills the medieval streets with sound every July. The architecture reflects a wealthy merchant past, with grand stone doorways and intricate carvings (like those at the 'House of the Seven Deadly Sins') that showcase the prosperity brought by the historic paper and blade trades.

For air travel, the nearest airport is Clermont-Ferrand Auvergne Airport (CFE), located approximately 35 kilometers (about a 30-minute drive) to the west. While CFE handles several domestic and select European connections, travelers seeking a wider range of international flights often use Lyon-Saint Exupéry Airport (LYS), which is roughly 145 kilometers to the east and reachable in about 90 minutes by car or via direct bus and train links.
