We offer for sale this exceptional property, a former mill, authentic and full of charm, dating from the 17th and 18th centuries, with a 15th-century section (former watermill), nestled in the heart of the Ecouves forest, beside a stream, with a pond, well, horse paddock, approximately 3 hectares of pastureland and a small poplar grove, all 5 km from Alençon.

This property is nestled in a delightful, peaceful, and secluded setting, facing south, and comprises:

A main house (former mill), including on the ground floor: an entrance hall, a hallway leading to a kitchen opening onto a large living room (terracotta tile floor) of 45m<sup>2</sup> and a sitting room/library with terracotta tiles, exposed beams, and a fireplace of approximately 36m<sup>2</sup>. A WC, a bedroom, a shower room, and an extension with a covered patio for outdoor dining or other uses.

You will also find a large paved terrace of approximately 150m<sup>2</sup>, a studio apartment on a mezzanine level with a fireplace and sleeping space.

On the first floor of this house, there are two large bedrooms with office areas (25 and 35m<sup>2</sup>), a master suite of 36m<sup>2</sup>, a shower room, and a WC.



On the second floor, there is a landing with a bedroom and an attic that could be converted.

In the basement, there is a large double garage, another garage under the covered patio, a laundry room, and a boiler room with a new heat pump and a hydrodynamic water heater.

Several outbuildings complete this property, including a stone building with a tiled roof of approximately 120m<sup>2</sup>, with a workshop, two former pigsties (with the possibility of creating stalls) and an attic upstairs, and a beautiful riding arena for working your horses.
