This is a large parcel of development land with panoramic sea views in an idyllic setting on Union Island located in the Cadastral District of Richmond of the Island as shown on the Lands and Survey Department registered survey Plan No 1136 Survey Order No P452/09 below. It measures 20,000M2 (4 acres) offering future owners the ability to create the home of their dreams in a peaceful environment, or alternatively for development of luxury holiday homes or a tourism project.

It is a rare opportunity to acquire a parcel of land of this size for either as a long term investment or to park capital on a small island that will undoubtedly appreciate in the future as an inflation hedge. It is equally an excellent chance to gain a foothold on this unspoiled island that is perfectly placed to enjoy everything the Caribbean has to offer and more but as yet, unknown so far, by many. Union Island is one of the most beautiful unspoiled islands of the SVG archipelago comprising a collection of 36 islands scattered like jewels in the surrounding seas.

Apart from the obvious benefits of the consistently good weather and there is pleasure and enjoyment on a small island drawing tourists [See link to website uion.island.com – ‘Your Caribbean Getaway’] there is also the Easterval celebration that takes place at Easter. Although the Island is just 9 square kilometres and is approximately 3 miles long and 1 mile wide the geographical landscape and hills make the island feel much bigger. Normally the Island has close to 3,000 residents although the population increases due to the influx of tourists throughout the year and yet it still manages to retain a charming relaxed atmosphere and easy way of life. Clean waters, a booming yachting scene and the two main towns of Ashton and Clifton are just a short drive away from the land on the concrete road as is Union Island Airport [IATA: UNI, ICAO: TVSU] near Clifton. The Airport mainly serves domestic flights to and from the main Island of SVG and is a major destination for flights to the other principal inhabited islands of SVG and also some regular and shared international flights to Barbados, Carriacou, Martinique, Grenada and St. Lucia.

The land itself sits on a gently sloping hill with scenic sea views overlooking Richmond Bay, with water, electricity connected and internet access, the opportunities are enormous. It is a rural setting with a few adjoining residential properties on the northern, southern and eastern boundaries and on the western boundary is a state-owned dry forest which is protected and offers remarkable biodiversity. There are a few neighbouring properties in and around the land ensuring the location is not at all isolated.

For those who enjoy sailing the options are endless with cruising available among the many islands that make up St Vincent & the Grenadines which is a tranquil paradise. The often deserted beaches of Union Island are simply outstandingly beautiful attracting tourism far and wide which is a key to its future prosperity.

The main island of St Vincent and the Grenadines is also a growing tourist destination with the modern Argyle International Airport opened in February 2017. TELECOMMUNICATIONS

Telecommunications are provided by Cable & Wireless who operate landline and wireless services (GSM) and Digicel offer competing wireless services, including the network formerly operated by AT&T Wireless/Cingular. High-Speed Internet services are provided by Cable and Wireless (512 kbit/s down, 128 kbit/s up). The island is connected to the Saint Vincent mainland by a series of digital microwave towers through connections to neighbouring islands of Canouan and Bequia. Household electricity is supplied by lines on poles on the adjoining road where there is also a drainage system serving the land and adjoining properties.

ABOUT THE AREA

The SVG archipelago is made up of a collection of 36 islands scattered like jewels in the surrounding



seas and the major ones being Carriacou, Young Island, Bequia, Canouan, Union Island, Mayreau, Petit St Vincent, and Palm Island and the remainder of which are smaller and mostly uninhabited. All are dependant on the nation of SVG which shares marine borders with Barbados, Grenada, Saint Lucia, Trinidad and Tobago and Venezuela. Union Island is known for its vibrant culture, with a mix of African, European, and Caribbean influences. The main language spoken is English but also a minority speak French owing to French colonialism before being replaced by UK colonialism until SVG independence.

The geographic location of Union Island makes it one of the most spectacular Caribbean Islands as it is surrounded by the beautiful Tobago Cays Marine Park and several other stunning private island resorts like Palm Island, Mustique and Petit St Vincent.
