ABOUT THE AREA

Calahonda is a beautiful coastal town that is 13 kilometres from Motril, located east of Carchuna.

It stands out as one of the most interesting tourist spots of the Tropical Coast of Granada, for its beautiful beaches and good conditions for diving. In fact, its name indicates that the water here is deeper and more transparent than in the whole coast. Thanks to its privileged location, which makes it a place of tourist attraction, its population multiplies in summer with the arrival of thousands of tourists.

Málaga is a port city on southern Spain's Costa del Sol, known for its high-rise hotels and resorts jutting up from yellow-sand beaches. Looming over that modern skyline are the city's 2 massive hilltop citadels, the Alcazaba and ruined Gibralfaro, remnants of Moorish rule. The city's soaring Renaissance cathedral is nicknamed La Manquita ('one-armed lady') because one of its towers was curiously left unbuilt.

If you think the Costa del Sol is soulless, you clearly haven't been to Málaga. Loaded with history and brimming with a youthful vigour that proudly acknowledges its multi-layered past, the city that gave the world Picasso has transformed itself in spectacular fashion, with half a dozen new art galleries, a radically rethought port area and a nascent art district called Soho. Not that Málaga was ever lacking in energy: the Spanish-to-the-core bar scene could put bags under the eyes of an insomniac madrileño, while the food culture encompasses both Michelin stars and tastefully tatty fish shacks.

Malaga is the cultural capital of the Costa del Sol. As well as a long, sandy shoreline, this vibrant city comes with cathedrals, castles and an up-and-coming arts scene. Every week, a new boutique or gourmet eatery opens on the waterfront, an area which recently had a top-to-toe makeover.

A flower and fountain-filled garden marks Malaga's centre. From here, it's just a couple of minutes' walk to the historic quarter, where you'll find sights like a 16th-century, dome-topped cathedral, a Roman amphitheatre and the Moorish Alcazaba Palace. You can map them all out from the hilltop Gibralfaro Castle, which offers up 360-degree views across the city.

As the birthplace of Picasso, Malaga has long been linked to the arts – an impressive collection of the painter's lesser-known works is housed in a museum dedicated to him. More recently, a mini version of



Paris' Pompidou Centre has popped up by the harbour, with exhibits by modern greats like Kahlo and Magritte.

Beyond its 16 sunny beaches, this Andalusian city on the shores of the Mediterranean has a fascinating cultural side. And the birthplace of Pablo Picasso has reinvented itself in recent year, inaugurating museums for all tastes.

If we take the combination of culture and the sea and add a lively atmosphere, numerous tapas served in bars, cutting-edge neighbourhoods like Soho, areas like the port that have transformed and become more modern and monuments with centuries of history, the result is a city full of passion that anyone would want to explore. Because if everyone says that Malaga is prettier than ever then it must be true.

Málaga is a province in southern Spain's Andalusia region. Mediterranean beach resorts like Marbella and Torremolinos line its Costa del Sol (Sun Coast). In the seaside capital, also called Málaga, the hilltop Alcazaba is an 11th-century Moorish citadel. The Málaga Cathedral has a baroque facade and an ornate Renaissance interior. The Museo Picasso showcases more than 200 works by locally born artist, Pablo Picasso.
