ABOUT THE AREA

Castelnuovo di Garfagnana is a town and comune in the province of Lucca, Toscana, central Italy. It is located at the confluence of the Serchio and the Turrone Secca rivers, close to the intersection of roads passing through the Apennine Mountains and the Apuan Alps. Castelnuovo di Garfagnana is a bustling town with road and rail links to Lucca, Pisa, Florence and the Versilia coast by Viareggio. The national parks of the Apuan Alps and Appenines are an easy drive away and open up a whole host of walks, nature and sports for your enjoyment.



The history of Castelnuovo can be traced back to as early as 740AD but within a century, the village had become an important town with defensive walls and castles. Its location enabled it to establish itself as a transit point for traders and visitors travelling to the northern areas of Italy. Over the centuries, the defensive walls and castles were enlarged and improved. In 1924, Castelnuovo became part of the Province of Lucca.

Even today, the defensive walls of Castelnuovo di Garfagnana play an important role in everyday life in Castelnuovo di Garfagnana. The walls contain the oldest parts of the town along with winding roads and small artisan shops. The more modern offices, residences, bars, restaurants and train station are outside of the walls. Many local residents commute to work in Lucca, Pisa or Florence whilst a growing number are able to make a comfortable living from tourism or from the sale of artisan gifts and paintings.

The history of Lucca Province dates back to ancient times, with evidence of Etruscan settlements found in the region. During the Roman era, Lucca became an important city and developed into a strategic military and commercial center.

Feast day of St Peter

St Peter is the patron saint of Castelnuovo di Garfagnana and the feast day on 29th June is celebrated by all the locals – many shops may close during the festivities.

Carnival

Castelnuovo di Garfagnana really gets into the spirit of Carnival time during February and you can watch the many floats parade through the town.

September Fair

The September Fair recreates the ancient importance Castelnuovo di Garfagnana held as a trading route between North and South. For 8 days, agricultural fayre is promoted for sale with a favourite being the local Garfagnino cheese. The tourist office has created a few new ideas to accompany the ancient traditions, one of which has proved very popular with the locals – Bingo in the main square!

The province of Lucca covers an area of 1.773 sq.km. It borders the Tyrrhenian sea to the west, the province of Massa-Carrara to the northwest, the province of Pisa to the south, the province of Pistoia to the northeast, the province of Florence to the east and the region of Emilia Romagna to the north.

Traditional Cuisine: The province offers a delectable array of Tuscan cuisine, including pasta dishes, soups like ribollita and farro soup, and various meat and cheese specialties. The local wines and olive oils are also highly regarded.
