Our bar is over 500 yrs old with the ruined chateau (tours offered) behind and in front a wonderful view of the historical alleyway leading to the archway and wooden gate where Joan of Arc and Bertrand Duguesclin took the last stand against the British.

The bar offers seating for 50 inside, 25 on the side terrace and in the square with picturesque fountain (hence the name La Fontaine!) the town granted for free seating for 36.

Music evenings were offered monthly, pub quiz monthly, coffee mornings and breakfasts for motorbike clubs.

The bar is on the route for the Santiago Camino and would be ideal for AirBnB as there is plenty of loft space for bedrooms etc.

There is a public car park behind the bar with parking for 45 cars plus walk way through large gardens
