It harmoniously blends authentic charm — with original floor tiles, exposed beams, and traditional features — with modern-day comfort. The home offers three bedrooms, two elegant bathrooms, a bright lounge, an open-plan fully fitted kitchen, and a lovely terrace with open views across the vines and surrounding countryside. Contemporary upgrades such as reversible air conditioning and modern bathroom fittings provide year-round comfort while preserving the warmth and soul of a historic village home.

The estate is fully equipped for winemaking, offering a professional and immediately operational setup. It includes a fully fitted winery with easy street access, a barrel cellar ideal for ageing wines, a temperature-controlled and insulated storage room, and a welcoming, climate-controlled tasting and retail space with disabled access. There is also a practical shelter for agricultural equipment. The property is



connected to mains water, has a well, is hooked up to the public sewer system, and benefits from fibre-optic internet and 380V electricity.

The Vineyard

The estate includes 6.3 hectares of vineyards, classified as AOP Languedoc (with pending recognition under AOP Pezenas) and IGP. The vines are planted with a rich variety of red and white grape varieties: Cinsault, Grenache blanc et gris, Carignan noir, Syrah, Vermentino, and Grenache noir. Managed under certified organic farming, the vineyard follows strict, environmentally respectful practices. Several parcels are set on rare volcanic basalt soils, creating a distinctive terroir for high-quality wines.

Business Activity

A refined range of red, rose and white wines is produced on-site, regularly awarded and enjoying international acclaim with coverage in the wine press abroad. Sales are well-balanced: 40% exported, 40% sold within France, and 20% sold directly at the estate. There is a strong annual turnover with significant growth potential. Both the brand and an established client database are included in the sale. Accounts on request.
