Other viable options include Pisa International Airport (PSA), roughly 140-150 kilometres (87-93 miles) west, and Bologna Guglielmo Marconi Airport (BLQ), approximately 160-170 kilometres (99-106 miles) north. Each of these airports offers good connections to European cities, and from there, Arezzo can be reached by a combination of train, bus, or rental car, with efficient rail links connecting Arezzo to major Italian cities like Florence and Rome.
