A large, welcoming eat-in kitchen provides the heart of the home — perfect for everyday living or entertaining — and connects seamlessly to the main living spaces. The balcony, with its direct views of the park and square, offers a peaceful outdoor spot in the middle of the city.



Located in the heart of the Boxhagener Kiez, the apartment is surrounded by a vibrant mix of cafes, restaurants, independent shops, and cultural spots. From the specialty brews at Silo Coffee to the natural wines at Briefmarken Weine, and the acclaimed Vietnamese fusion at 1990 Vegan Living, the culinary scene here is second to none. The weekly Saturday market on the square and the legendary Sunday flea market bring the area to life with local produce, handmade goods, and vintage treasures. Just around the corner, RAW-Gelände offers nightlife, galleries, and open-air events, while the peaceful banks of the Spree River are a short walk away, perfect for cycling or a quiet stroll.

Culture lovers will appreciate the nearby Intimes Kino, one of Berlin's classic independent cinemas, while green space is right outside your door — a true luxury in this part of the city. Public transport connections are excellent, with Samariterstrasse (U5), Warschauer Strasse (U- and S-Bahn), and several tram lines within easy reach, offering quick access to Mitte, Kreuzberg, Prenzlauer Berg, and the wider city.

This is more than just an apartment — it's a front-row seat to one of Berlin's most dynamic neighbourhoods, offering both tranquillity and the unmistakable spirit of Friedrichshain right at your doorstep.

City area

Located in East Berlin, Friedrichshain is a lively and trendy district reminding of Berlin's Soviet past of the city. The Karl-Marx Allee, linking Alexanderplatz to Frankfurter Tor, offers a striking example of Stalinist architecture with its impressive dimensions. It is also a verdant area, especially the Volkspark, famous for its barbecue areas and the outdoor cinema. The area many shops, bars and restaurants around the Boxhagener Platz, famous for its flea market. The RAW, a cultural and alternative place, consists of former hangars converted into workshops, restaurants, sports halls, bars and clubs. Along the Spree, the former Berlin Wall has become an open-air art gallery, the East Side Gallery, hosting paintings by international artists. For several years now, this area has been experiencing real estate expansion. Several international companies, including Zalando, have established their headquarters in the neighbourhood.
