Riba-roja d'Ebre is a captivating municipality nestled in the Ribera d'Ebre comarca of the province of Tarragona, Catalonia, Spain. Strategically located along the meandering course of the Ebro River, it is the first village the Ebro encounters upon entering Catalonia, giving it a unique character shaped by the powerful waterway. The town's identity is intrinsically linked to its riverside setting, offering a blend of rich history, stunning natural landscapes, and a strong connection to water-based activities. Riba-roja d'Ebre provides a tranquil yet engaging environment for residents and visitors seeking an authentic taste of rural Catalonia.

The history of Riba-roja d'Ebre is deeply etched by the Ebro River, which served as a crucial communication and trade route since ancient times. A larger international option is Barcelona-El Prat Airport (BCN), situated about 180 kilometers (around 112 miles) away, with a driving time of approximately 2 hours and 15 minutes. Barcelona Airport offers a more extensive range of international flights and airlines. Another alternative, sometimes with cheaper flights, is Zaragoza Airport (ZAZ), located in the Aragon region, with a similar driving time to Barcelona. Riba-roja d'Ebre also has a train station, offering direct rail connections to Barcelona and Reus, providing



an alternative to car travel for reaching this enchanting riverside town.
