From Fortaleza, visitors can arrange private transfers, take intercity buses to Aracati (a nearby city just 9km from Canoa Quebrada) and then a local minivan, or opt for shared shuttle services directly to Canoa Quebrada. Additionally, the Aracati Airport (ARX), officially known as Canoa Quebrada Dragão do Mar Regional Airport, is closer to Canoa Quebrada at about 20 kilometers away. While this regional airport offers even more direct access, it currently does not have regular scheduled commercial flights, making Fortaleza the main airport for most international and domestic arrivals.
