Chantada is a charming and historic town located in the province of Lugo, within the autonomous community of Galicia, Spain. Often referred to as the 'heart of Galicia,' its unique geographical location between the Miño Canyon and Monte Faro provides a stunning blend of mountain and riverside scenery. The town's beautiful old quarter is a delight to explore, with its traditional arcades and cobblestone streets. Chantada is also a key part of the Ribeira Sacra, a region famous for its 'heroic viticulture,' where winemakers cultivate grapes on incredibly steep, terraced slopes overlooking the Miño and Sil rivers. This rich agricultural heritage is reflected in its local cuisine, wines, and the bustling monthly fair where local producers sell their goods.

The municipality is steeped in history, with archaeological evidence of prehistoric settlements and numerous Romanesque architectural treasures.
