In the basement there is a spacious storage room, ideal for storing food and tools, as well as a spacious garage with a charging station for electric vehicles and technical rooms for the photovoltaic system and the heating system. The inner courtyard leads to the first floor, which boasts an open-plan living and dining area, complemented by a classic wood-burning stove and access to the balcony. An internal staircase leads to the upper floor, where there are two further bedrooms, a storage room, a bathroom, a separate WC and a further living area with fireplace and adjoining kitchen. Here, too, there is access to several balconies that offer wonderful views. On the top floor there is another spacious bedroom with its own bathroom and plenty of privacy.
