Description:

Set in a rural location steeped in history, this charming medieval property is part of a former 13th century sheepfold, to which a tower was added in the 20th century. With a total living area of approximately 310 m2, the property comprises a main house of 210 m2 (offering 3 to 4 bedrooms, a 55 m2 courtyard, and a 32 m2 terrace with lovely unobstructed views) and a separate 100 m2 gite (currently rented out, ideal for additional rental income).

The property is set on 7447 m2 of land, which also includes a working wine cellar, currently rented out, adding further potential to the property.

Work required: renovation of the heating system, bringing the septic tank up to standard, and general refurbishment of the house.

An authentic and unique property, ideal for lovers of old buildings and renovation projects in a wine-growing environment.

- Location: Rural location with no shops, 10 minutes from Laurens and Autignac, 25 minutes from Beziers and 30 minutes from the beaches and Beziers airport.



- Ground floor: 16 m2 entrance hall, 13.5 m2 office, 55 m2 living room with access to a 55 m2 courtyard.
- 1st floor: 12 m2 hall/mezzanine with fixed kitchen units and access to a 32 m2 terrace, 4 m2 shower room (shower, washbasin), access to the 2nd floor, 5 m2 sink/laundry area, WC, 18 m2 bedroom with access to the terrace, 14 m2 bedroom, 2 m2 hall.
- 2nd floor: 20.3 m2 bedroom/study with access to a 17.5 m2 bedroom, 14 m2 bedroom (tower).
- Guest Gite: 32 m2 kitchen (wall and base units, electric oven, hob, extractor hood, fridge, sink), 12.6 m2 bedroom with 2.4 m2 shower room (shower, washbasin, toilet), 17 m2 en-suite bedroom with 4 m2 shower room (walk-in shower, toilet, bidet, washing machine area).
- Outside: 55 m2 courtyard, 32 m2 terrace, surrounded by approximately 5000 m2 of land, in the heart of a wine estate, wine cellar of over 300 m2 in use and with a floor to renovate (or storage space).
- Miscellaneous: Heating with fireplace (improvements required), annual property tax of about 2000 Euros, septic tank to be installed, mains water and electricity, holiday cottage rented at 550 Euros/month, cellar rented per month, 18 months' notice required to recover the wine cellar and holiday cottage, agricultural shed (for tractors).
