Historically, it served as a coveted summer retreat for the Roman nobility, a tradition that began during the Roman Empire and peaked during the Renaissance and Baroque periods. This era saw the construction of magnificent estates known as the Tusculan Villas, which became symbols of wealth and status. Though damaged during World War II, the most prominent of these, such as the imposing Villa Aldobrandini, still dominate the landscape and define the town's aristocratic charm.
