Pfatten (Italian: Vadena) is a small municipality in South Tyrol, Italy, and belongs to the district community of Überetsch-Unterland. The village is located in the Adige Valley, south of the provincial capital of Bolzano, and is characterized by its picturesque landscape, its historical significance and its proximity to some of the most famous sights in South Tyrol.

#### Geography

Pfatten lies at an altitude of around 243 meters above sea level and covers an area of around 13.5 square kilometers. The town is crossed by the Adige, the largest river in South Tyrol, and is surrounded by vineyards, forests and hills. The municipality borders the towns of Bolzano and Laives as well as the municipalities of Appiano and Caldaro.



## History of Pfatten

The history of Pfatten dates back to pre-Roman times. Archaeological finds indicate that the region was settled early on. Later, the area was part of the Roman Empire, as evidenced by the remains of ancient roads and settlements. In the Middle Ages, Pfatten belonged to the county of Tyrol and played a role as an agricultural center.

## Economy

The economy of Pfatten is strongly characterized by agriculture, especially viticulture. The village is located in one of the most renowned wine regions in South Tyrol, the Überetsch-Unterland. In addition to wine, fruit is also grown, especially apples. The proximity to Bolzano has also contributed to the development of tourism and crafts.

## Places of interest

**Lake Kaltern:** Pfatten is located near Lake Kaltern, one of the warmest Alpine lakes and a popular destination for those seeking relaxation and water sports.

**St. Valentin parish church:** This church is a historic building and an example of the sacred architecture of the region.

**Adige Cycle Path:** The Adige Cycle Path, a popular cycle route, runs through Pfatten and connects the village with other communities along the river.
