The ground floor comprises five main rooms: a 15 m2 fitted kitchen, a spacious 26 m2 dining room, a welcoming 20 m2 living room, two bedrooms of 9 m2 and 12 m2, a bathroom with shower and toilet, and a 19 m2 utility room.

Outbuildings include an attached 20 sq m barn currently used as a boiler room, and a spacious 40 sq m garage. The house's real asset lies in its 130 sq m attic, which is fully convertible and offers exceptional expansion possibilities.

The property is immediately habitable but requires some work to unlock its full potential: interior wall



insulation, installation of a dual-flow ventilation system, and replacement of the current oil-fired central heating system with an air-to-water heat pump.

The roof is in very good condition.

Located in a peaceful, rural setting, the house benefits from quick access to amenities thanks to its proximity to La Loupe train station, facilitating travel to Paris or Chartres.
