It offers a superb living space of 298 m², with a spacious and luminous living room with a fully fitted open-plan kitchen, a utility room/pantry, a lounge, 3 bathrooms, 4 bedrooms (including a master suite), as well as a magnificent 100 m² room with exposed beams that may be adapted to your needs and desires (gym, yoga studio, cinema room, games room: a wide range of possibilities.).

In addition, the property benefits from a courtyard and a terrace on either side of the house, as well as a vast 100 m² garage.

A refined blend of modern comfort and period features - right in the heart of the village.

- Location: A lively village with all amenities (bakery, butcher, tabac, supermarkets, schools:), located at 15 minutes from Beziers and 25 minutes from the beaches.

- Basement: Very spacious garage of 100 m² with several adjoining rooms and a well (not suitable for large vehicles, only for standard-sized cars).



- Ground floor: Entrance hall of 22.83 m² with its beautiful original stone staircase, lounge (which may also serve as an additional bedroom or office) of 15.58 m² with decorative marble fireplace, shower room of 3.62 m² (shower, washbasin unit, WC), superb luminous through-living room of almost 50 m² open onto a fully equipped kitchen (central island and ample storage, electric hob, sink, electric oven, microwave, built-in refrigerator, cupboards) with an elegant period granite marble fireplace and French doors leading to the terrace, utility room/pantry of 10.50 m².
