This penthouse represents an ideal primary residence, holiday home, or investment opportunity within one of the Algarves most desirable and characterful locations, often referred to as the Venice of the Algarve.

TAVIRA

Set gracefully on both banks of the meandering Rio Gilão, Tavira is often called the "Venice of the Algarve" not for its canals, but for its serene beauty, iconic bridges, and romantic ambiance. Unlike the



more commercialised resorts of the central Algarve, Tavira remains deeply authentic, blending a rich Moorish and Roman heritage with a modern, laid-back lifestyle. As you wander through the cobbled streets lined with azulejo-tiled façades, ancient churches, and blooming jacaranda trees, it becomes clear why Tavira is often described as the Algarves most enchanting town. With over 37 churches, many dating back to the Middle Ages, and a 7-arched Roman bridge said to have been reconstructed during the 17th century, Tavira offers a journey through centuries of Portuguese history. But Tavira is more than just a historic town it's a thriving community that blends culture, nature, and a growing international presence, making it an attractive location for both visitors and expats alike.

Tavira's timeless architecture sits alongside a vibrant contemporary culture. The town's Mercado da Ribeira, a beautifully restored 19th-century market hall, now hosts trendy cafés, artisan shops, and cultural events. The modern municipal market, meanwhile, is a feast for the senses, with fresh produce, local fish, cheeses, and flowers filling the air with aroma and colour. Tavira is also increasingly known for its strong sustainability ethos, with eco-tourism, organic farming, and conservation of the nearby Ria Formosa Natural Park being central to local policy. BEACHES & NATURAL WONDERS

Tavira is blessed with access to some of the most pristine and picturesque beaches in Portugal, thanks to its location adjacent to the Ria Formosa Natural Park, a protected lagoon system and one of Europe's most important wetlands.

Ilha de Tavira (Tavira Island)

Just a short ferry ride from the town, this island stretches over 11 kilometres and features white sands, dunes, and crystal-clear water. It's a Blue Flag beach, indicating exceptional cleanliness and facilities. Tavira Island offers calm waters ideal for families, and its small beach village provides a variety of seaside restaurants and bars.

Praia do Barril

Famous for the Cemitério das Âncoras (Anchor Cemetery), a hauntingly beautiful installation of over 100 rusting tuna boat anchors, this beach was once a thriving centre for the tuna fishing industry. Today, it's a peaceful and spacious beach accessible via a charming miniature train that runs from the mainland through the Ria Formosa wetlands.

Ilha de Cabanas

A tranquil stretch of sand near the fishing village of Cabanas de Tavira, this beach is ideal for long walks, swimming, and watching the traditional fishing boats glide across the water. It remains relatively untouched and serene even in peak season.

Secret Spots

Tavira also hides some lesser-known natural gems. Praia da Terra Estreita, a narrow and quiet beach accessed by boat from Santa Luzia, offers off-the-beaten-track tranquillity, while inland, Pego do Inferno, a hidden waterfall and swimming hole in the hills, provides a magical spot to cool off in the summer.



CULINARY HAVEN

Food lovers will feel at home in Tavira, which is famous for its octopus, caught locally in the village of Santa Luzia, the self-declared Octopus Capital of Portugal.

The town offers everything from rustic taverns serving bacalhau à brás and cataplana de marisco, to fine dining establishments that pair creative interpretations of Algarve cuisine with award-winning Portuguese wines.
