It is distinguished by its authentic stone arches on both the lower and upper floors—a rare feature, as most local homes only feature them on a single level. This architectural significance is so profound that the home is featured in the prestigious digest 'Ancient Houses from Valsesia' by architect Comoli Mandracci.



Architectural Authenticity & Layout

Spanning a generous 283 m², the main residence is arranged over two floors around a private, sun-drenched inner courtyard. This is a home of manageable proportions that retains its soulful, period integrity, making it the perfect candidate for a sensitive restoration.

The current layout includes:

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Living Quarters: Four spacious bedrooms and three reception rooms bathed in natural light. The home currently features 1.5 bathrooms.

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Heritage Features: A traditional kitchen featuring its original wood-fired bread oven, solid wood plank flooring, exposed timber beam ceilings, and original timber-framed windows.

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The Vaults: Extensive, dry, brick-vaulted cellars offer an incredible foundation for a private wine cellar, a rustic 'taverna,' or a bespoke home cinema.

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Expansion Potential: A former hayloft and a full-sized attic space are primed for conversion into additional living or creative areas.

The property sits on a total plot of approximately 360 m², which encompasses the house, a charming pleasure garden, and a larger orchard. The outdoor spaces are a true highlight, offering:

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Leisure Potential: Ample scope exists to install a swimming pool within the orchard or to create a dedicated spa sanctuary within the adjoining rustic structures (subject to planning).

Valduggia is the birthplace of the Renaissance master Gaudenzio Ferrari, and that creative spirit lingers in this laid-back village. Here, you can enjoy a slow-paced life supported by local amenities and vibrant gastronomic festivals. For the active soul, numerous hiking trails start right at your doorstep, while the crystalline waters of Lakes Orta and Maggiore are just a short drive away. For a change of pace, the Ligurian Sea is less than two hours away via motorway.

ABOUT THE AREA

Valduggia is a picturesque commune tucked away in the Valsesia region of the Province of Vercelli, situated in the northern Italian region of Piedmont. It is characterized by its tranquil, verdant setting where the foothills of the Alps begin to rise, offering a serene atmosphere far removed from the frantic pace of Italy's major metropolitan centers. The village is famously known as the 'Village of the Bells,' a title earned through its centuries-old tradition of bell founding, most notably by the Mazzola family, whose craftsmanship has echoed through churches across Europe for generations.

The architectural character of Valduggia is a charming mix of rustic stone dwellings and elegant historic buildings that reflect its industrial and artisanal prosperity. Walking through its center, visitors can admire the Church of San Giorgio, which houses significant local artworks, and several ornate chapels that dot the surrounding hillsides. The town serves as a gateway to the high Valsesia valley, making it a perfect starting point for hikers and nature enthusiasts looking to explore the Monte Fenere Natural Park, which is rich in archaeological sites and diverse flora.

Economically and culturally, Valduggia has successfully transitioned from its traditional bell-making roots into a modern industrial hub, particularly specializing in the production of valves and taps. The airport provides extensive global connections and is conveniently linked to Valduggia via the A26 motorway. Alternatively, Milan Linate Airport (LIN) and Turin Airport (TRN) are also accessible within a 90-minute drive, providing further flexibility for visitors exploring the stunning landscape of Vercelli and the wider Piedmont region.
