ABOUT THE AREA

Stafford, Virginia, serves as a vital historical and geographic link between Washington, D.C., and Richmond. Formally established in 1664 and named after Staffordshire, England, the county is steeped in early American history. It is famously home to Ferry Farm, the childhood home of George Washington, where the future president lived from age six until early adulthood. The region also played a critical role in the construction of the nation's capital; Government Island, a historic quarry in Stafford, provided the Aquia sandstone used to build both the White House and the U.S. Capitol.

Beyond its colonial roots, Stafford was a central theater of operation during the American Civil War. Though it was not the site of massive pitched battles, it endured a heavy toll as a logistical hub, hosting over 100,000 Union troops during the winter of 1862–1863. Sites like Chatham Manor, a Georgian-style mansion, served as a Union headquarters and hospital where figures like Clara Barton and Walt Whitman tended to the wounded. Today, the Stafford Civil War Park preserves the remains of encampments and fortifications, offering a somber look at the 'Union Army's Valley Forge.'

In 2026, Stafford stands as one of the fastest-growing and wealthiest counties in the United States. Its economy is deeply intertwined with the federal government and military, notably anchored by Marine Corps Base Quantico to the north and a significant presence of defense contractors and intelligence agencies, including the FBI Academy. The county's strategic location along the I-95 corridor makes it a preferred residential choice for professionals working in Northern Virginia and the D.C. metro area, blending high-income suburban development with preserved natural spaces.

The geography of Stafford is defined by its relationship with water and nature, bordered by the Potomac River to the east and the Rappahannock River to the south. Residents and visitors enjoy a variety of recreational outlets, from the picturesque Widewater Peninsula—a historic fishing spot favored by past



presidents—to modern amenities like Potomac Point Winery. With a population that has soared toward 160,000, Stafford continues to evolve from its rural, agricultural beginnings into a sophisticated suburban community that meticulously honors its four centuries of American heritage.
