Kajaani is a vibrant city located in the heart of the Kainuu region in central Finland, known for its rich cultural history and stunning lakeside scenery. Founded in 1651 by Count Per Brahe the Younger, it serves as a gateway between the southern Lake District and the rugged wilderness of Lapland. The city is defined by the Kajaani River, which flows through the center and historically powered the local tar industry, once the backbone of the regional economy.



The city's most iconic landmark is the Kajaani Castle ruins, located on an island in the middle of the river. Originally built in the 17th century to defend the eastern border of the Swedish Empire, the fortress saw heavy action during the Great Northern War before being largely destroyed. Today, visitors can walk through the stone remains, which offer a tangible connection to the city's military past and provide a picturesque backdrop for local events and walks along the riverbank.

Beyond its history, Kajaani is a hub for outdoor enthusiasts and culture seekers alike. It sits on the shores of Lake Oulujärvi, Finland's fourth-largest lake, offering ample opportunities for fishing, boating, and swimming in the summer, or ice fishing and cross-country skiing in the winter.
