A formal, representative dining room connects seamlessly to a spacious 35-square-meter traditional-style kitchen, ideal for hosting large family gatherings or catering events. Set upon approximately 2,500 square meters of private land arranged over two distinct terraced levels, the

Wide, open-air terraces seamlessly extend the indoor living spaces into the outdoors, providing ideal vantage points for al fresco dining, entertaining, or simply soaking in the expansive views of the Adriatic Coast.

The upper garden level features a large above-ground swimming pool surrounded by sunbathing terraces, offering a private oasis refreshed by coastal breezes. Whether relaxing by the pool or enjoying a morning coffee on the elevated balconies, the sea panorama serves as a constant, tranquil backdrop.

Complete Privacy, Access, and Parking

Privacy and ease of access are paramount throughout the estate. The property is approached via its own private, dedicated access road, fully illuminated by classic street lamps that lead gracefully up to the residence. Three separate entrances from the main street—one equipped with an automated gate and two secure keyed entrances—ensure convenience for residents, staff, and guests alike.

Vehicle storage includes a spacious, double automated garage covering 35 square meters. In addition to the garage, the private access road provides ample, secure off-street parking for multiple vehicles, easily accommodating large gatherings.

Montesilvano Colle combines the tranquility of an ancient Italian hilltop village with quick access to modern conveniences. The property sits just minutes from the beaches of Montesilvano Spiaggia and the vibrant urban center of Pescara.

Transportation is exceptionally convenient. The nearest airport is Abruzzo International Airport (PSR) in Pescara, located roughly 10 to 12 kilometers away (a 15-minute drive). The airport offers regular domestic and European flight connections, making this estate an ideal primary residence or an easily accessible holiday escape.

Perched on a hilltop overlooking the Adriatic Sea, Montesilvano Colle is the historic center of Montesilvano in the Abruzzo region of Italy. While the lower coastal town, Montesilvano Spiaggia, thrives as a modern beach resort, the Colle (hill) offers a quiet step back in time. It preserves the ancient heart of the municipality, granting sweeping views of the surrounding countryside, the coastline, and the distant peaks of the Apennines.

The medieval village is characterized by narrow cobblestone streets, stone archways, and restored historic homes. At its core stands the Church of San Michele Arcangelo, an ancient structure featuring architectural elements dating back to the Middle Ages. Strolling through the peaceful piazza and along the belvedere terraces provides panoramic viewpoints, making it a popular spot for visitors looking to experience authentic Italian village charm away from coastal crowds.



Life in Montesilvano Colle revolves around tradition, local heritage, and regional gastronomy. The hill comes alive during local summer festivals and evening gatherings, where small taverns serve authentic Abruzzese specialties like arrosticini (grilled mutton skewers) and local Montepulciano d'Abruzzo wine. Its relaxed, residential atmosphere provides a distinct contrast to the bustling energy of neighboring Pescara, making it an ideal retreat for travelers exploring central Italy.
