Alternatively, hop-on-hop-off boats glide along the Seine. And, Velib' bike stations on every corner make it easy to whizz around on two wheels.

Year-round festivals

All throughout the year, Paris' calendar of events is full to the brim. Bastille Day is the big one. On this date in July, there's a parade along the Champs Élysées and fireworks at the Eiffel Tower, to celebrate France's independence. For the Nuit des Musees, in May, the museums stay open all night and let visitors



in for free. Then there's the June Fete de la Musique, when tunes from free, open-air concerts echo through the streets.
